Examinations	In order to sit the exams, online registration is necessary. It is possible between 14 and 3 days before the date of the exam. The mark is out of 30, from a minimum of 18 to a maximum of 30. The exams are predominantly oral.	
Courses available for Exchange students	Erasmus incoming students can choose freely from the academic offer of the School of Humanities and Education, independently of the study area in which they were nominated. They can take courses from up to another School, up to 50% of the total credits.

Language Requirements	The University of Florence requires students to submit a certification of knowledge of Italian at B1 level , as defined by the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. We however recommend a higher level to maximize the chances of success in their academic pursuits. A B2 certificate in English is required ONLY IF the student chooses English-taught courses.	
Nomination Procedure	In order to be accepted by the School of Humanities and Education, the HOME INSTITUTION of students selected within the framework of the ERASMUS+ programme must send an official NOMINATION through the following dedicated form https://forms.gle/jdT1hfeisgrsvbWQ9 Nomination deadlines: 1st semester or full-year: 31st May 2nd semester: 31st October	



Application Procedure	<p>After the University has officially nominated the students, we will contact the student with further information. <i>Please note:</i> we do not accept students' self-nominations</p> <p>In order to proceed with the application, students will need to send:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• a copy of <u>Learning Agreement on EWP</u> if the partner University is on the system, otherwise on pdf format• a PDF of <u>Student mobility Proposal Form</u> (Enrolment Form) duly stamped and signed• B1 Italian language certificate (mandatory)• pdf copy of passport or national identity card (high quality scan, no phone pictures) <p>The above-mentioned documentation with the signatures and the stamps of your home institution must be sent via the dedicated form which will be published at the following link: https://www.st-umaform.unifi.it/vp-358-application-procedure.html</p> <p><i>Please note:</i> forms without signatures and stamps cannot be approved.
